All coaches and chaperones must be at least eighteen (18) years old by the start of Alberta Games.

#### PROVINCIAL GAMES REGISTRATION FEE AND DEADLINE

All zone team competitors, who qualify to compete at the 2016 Alberta Winter Games (excluding coaches and chaperones), are required to pay an individual registration fee of \$60.00. This fee will go towards offsetting the costs related to transportation, accommodation, meals, zone identification, medals, athlete entertainment and sport competitions. This fee must accompany the athlete's registration for the Provincial Games.
