3 Team Registration	(g)	All Junior C teams that designate only one (1) goaltender will be restricted to register only twenty-two (22) players (it should be noted that only <del>19</del> 17 skaters can dress for any given Hockey Canada, Hockey Alberta, or Hockey Calgary Junior C game). Teams that register two (2) goaltenders can register the maximum number of players at twenty-three (23).	Updated to reflect current practice and align with Hockey Alberta.
3 Team Registration	(i)	Team Officials participating "on the bench" with any duly registered Hockey Team must be Duly registered in the Registry prior to participating with said team.	Added to align with Hockey Alberta Regulation B 3.9
3 Team Registration	(j)	Team Officials participating "on the bench" with more than one (1) Hockey Team in the same season shall be duly registered with each and every team of which she/he is a member prior to participating with the respective team(s). 28 Playoff Overtime Rules	(a)	<p>In Midget AA and Junior B (CJHL) leagues, games tied at the end of regulation will continue with a "sudden death" overtime in the following manner:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Game Clock will be set to the remainder of the time permit.</li> <li>2. The first 5 minutes will be played 4 on 4 (plus goalie).</li> <li>3. Following the first stoppage of play after the first 5 minutes, the overtime will be played 3 on 3 (plus goalie).</li> <li>4. If the game remains tied after the overtime period, a "sudden death" shootout will commence to determine a winner. No player may shoot twice until everyone who is eligible has shot.</li> </ol>	Updated to reflect new practice.
	(b)	<p>If a penalty occurs in the first 5 minutes, teams will play 5 on 4 (plus goalie). If a second penalty occurs against the shorthanded team prior to the expiration of the first penalty, teams will play 5 on 3 (plus goalie). If a penalty occurs or is being served following the first stoppage of play after the first 5 minutes, teams will play 4 on 3 (plus goalie). If a second penalty occurs against the shorthanded team prior to the expiration of the first penalty, teams will play 5 on 3 (plus goalie). At the first stoppage of play following the expiration of a penalty, teams will return to 4 on 4 (plus goalie) or 3 on 3 (plus goalie).</p>	Updated to reflect new practice.
