**SUBJECT: CARRY-OVER SUSPENSIONS AND PRE-SEASON SUSPENSIONS**

### **CARRY-OVER SUSPENSIONS**

Players with carryover suspensions from last season will be allowed to participate in their Community “try-outs”, exhibition and sanctioned tournament games during the pre season for the purposes of evaluations. All carryover suspensions will be served in their entirety at the start of league play or a sanctioned tournament.

### **2013 PRE-SEASON SUSPENSIONS**

Should any player receive a one game suspension during pre season play they will be allowed to serve their suspension in sanctioned tournament games only (not exhibition games) prior to the start of league play.

All one game suspensions must be served at the start of league play if no pre season tournament games remain. *The player may continue to play exhibition games for the purpose of evaluations.*

If a player receives a second suspension during pre season they will be suspended from the pre season evaluation process indefinitely until further review.

Any player receiving a multiple game suspension or Match penalty will be suspended from the pre season evaluation process.

Any and all suspendable incidents are to be reported immediately to their Category Governor and League Chair.
