### **U9 & U11 (except AA) - No Provincials at these Age Categories**

#### **U11 AA HA ‘Alberta One’ model (March 26-29, 2026)**

*8 Team Provincial - 1 league champion, from the 5 divisions within Alberta, 2 wildcard teams and 1 host team*

- The HC Representative will be the regular season **‘League Champion’**

#### **U13 – HA ‘Alberta One’ model (March 19-22, 2026)**

*8 Team Provincial - 1 league champion, from the 6 leagues within Alberta, 1 wildcard team and 1 host team*

- Hockey Calgary will participate in the following divisions:
  - U13 Tier 1 (A)
  - U13 Tier 2 (B)
  - U13 Tier 3 (C)
  - U13 Tier 4 (D)
- The HC Representative will be the regular season **‘League Champion’**
  - Team at the top of the regular season standings at the conclusion of the regular season. Tie breaking procedures can be found in the [Hockey Calgary Regulations Handbook](#)
- Due to Hockey Calgary having both North & South Leagues, the HC Rep will be determined by a 1 game ‘play-in’ game, between the **‘North Division League Champion’** and the **‘South Division League Champion’**.
  - ‘Play-In’ Games will be played on **Tuesday, February 24, 2026**, for the sole purpose of determining a ‘Provincial Representative’. These games will not count as part of Hockey Calgary’s City Championships.

### U21 C (Junior C) - (March 27-29, 2026)

*6 Team Provincial – 3 from Hockey Calgary, 3 from NJHL*

- The HC Representatives will be:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Rep – 'Playoff Champion'
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Rep – 'Playoff Runner Up'
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Rep – 'Playoff 3<sup>rd</sup> Place'
    - A one game 'Play-in' game will be played between the 2 losing teams of the Semi-Finals series to determine Hockey Calgary's 3<sup>rd</sup> Provincials Rep.
