TEAM QUALIFICATIONS

Team Qualifications must be obtained by the deadlines indicated below or sanctions may be applied against the offending registered Player, Team or Team Official as appropriate. For more information on all mandatory programs relating to qualifications please refer to *Hockey Canada – Regulation E-1(a)*, *Hockey Alberta - Regulation E* and *Hockey Calgary - Rules and Regulations 4-6*.

Team Official Qualifications

Only those individuals listed on the HCR official team roster are covered by liability insurance therefore any person who will regularly step on the bench or the ice should be registered as a team official however a maximum of five (5) team officials may be present on the bench during games. Certification is required by November 15 of the current playing season.

*All registered Team Officials must be certified in the Respect in Sport - Coach Edition. The old Hockey Canada Speak Out Abuse and Harassment is grandfathered and equivalent to Respect in Sport - Coach Edition.

** One registered team official must be certified in the Hockey Canada Safety Program and must be in attendance at all games.

*** The old Intro to Coach and Coach Level certifications have been integrated into the new Coach Stream certification. Timbits teams must have two registered team officials certified in the old Intro to Coach or new Coach Stream. All head coaches of Novice and above teams (other than AA & AAA) must have completed the old Coach Level or new Coach Stream.

Calgary Hockey Development administers all NCCP levels, the Hockey Canada Safety Program and the Checking Skills Program on behalf of Hockey Calgary. For more information on these clinics and to register visit www.eshootscores.com.

The Speak Out/Abuse and Harassment Program developed by Hockey Canada in 1997 is no longer offered however certification is considered equivalent to the Hockey Canada Respect In Sport (RIS) Coach Program. Respect In Sport (RIS) Parent Qualification

At least one (1) parent of every registered player must have completed the Hockey Calgary RIS Parent Program by October 15 of the current playing season. The RIS Parent program is an online course and is available at <https://hockeyalbertaparent.respectgroupinc.com/secure/>. There is no equivalency; certification is mandatory regardless of any other RIS certification the parent may possess.
