Subject: **Respect in Sport Certification October 15<sup>th</sup> Deadline**

The purpose of this communication is to remind you of your respective responsibilities:

- 1) Inform all Association member families that the completion deadline is 11:59 pm, Oct 15, 2010.
- 2) Advise all members that access to the RIS program is available through the Hockey Calgary website at ([www.hockeycalgary.com](http://www.hockeycalgary.com)) or by selecting the following link: <https://hockeycalgary.respectgroupinc.com/secure/>
- 3) Ensure that all members fully understand that noncompliance will result in loss of playing privileges for their son/daughter until proof of completion of the RIS training has been provided. (No exceptions!)
- 4) It is your responsibility to verify and confirm that all players formally registered to a team, in fact have a corresponding RIS certification number affiliated with his/her HCR player profile.
- 5) You are responsible to report to Beth Long at the Hockey Calgary office any errors, omissions or noncompliance details related to the RIS certification by noon on Oct 16, 2010.

- 6) Post noon, Oct 16, 2010 you are required to communicate with all noncompliant families that their son's/daughter's eligibility for continued play has been revoked until completion of the RIS training has been completed and verified to the satisfaction of Hockey Calgary.
- 7) You are responsible to reinstate player eligibility once the conditions in point 6 have been met.

**Warning**

As there has been significant promotion and communication associated with the RIS program over the past season leading up to the date of this correspondence, we are confirming our intention to cancel games if necessary on or after the 16<sup>th</sup> of October should any team have insufficient RIS certified registered players to participate in a hockey game in accordance with Hockey Canada rule 2.2 (a) Players In Uniform.
