OVERTIME FORMAT:

If teams are tied at the end of regulation, overtime will commence in the following manner;

- 1) There will be no flood prior to overtime and teams will not change ends;
- 2) The first five (5) minutes of a twenty (20) minute overtime period will be played 5 on 5 (plus goalie);
- 3) If the teams are still tied the next five (5) minutes will be played 4 on 4 (plus goalie);
- 4) If the teams are still tied, the next ten (10) minutes will be played 3 on 3 (plus goalie);
- 5) If a goal has not been scored at the end of the first overtime period and permit time remains a second 20 minute period will commence with teams playing 3 on 3
 - a) if the game remains tied and can not be concluded due to unforeseen circumstances, the team that scored first in the game in question shall be declared
 - b) if the game ends 0-0 then the team with the fewest penalty minutes in regulation will be declared the winner.
 - c) if the teams are still tied in penalty minutes then the team with the most goals in the current playoff series will be declared the winner.
 - d) if the teams are tied as this is the first game of the series then the team with the most goals in the regular season will be declared the winner.
 - e) if the teams are still tied then the team with the fewest goals against in the regular season will be declared the winner.
 - f) if the teams are still tied then the higher ranked team in the regular season standings will be declared the winner.
